**(DECLARE A STATE OF EMERGENCY WITH RESPECT TO THE DICKERSON
POND SEWER DISTRICT)**

WHEREAS, the Dickerson Pond Sewer District services approximately 230 separate dwelling units; and

WHEREAS, the sewage treatment plant is currently not functional because of infrastructural failures; and

WHEREAS, due to these infrastructural failures, the Town of Cortlandt staff is overseeing the pumping of the sewer plant and transportation of raw sewage to a receiving facility each day; and

WHEREAS, the Town Supervisor is authorized to declare a local State of Emergency pursuant to Section 24 of the Executive Law; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor and Town Board seek to preserve the public safety and render all required assistance vital to the security, well-being, and health of the citizens of Cortlandt;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board receives, files, and confirms the State of Emergency declared by the Town Supervisor with respect to the Dickerson Pond Sewer District, which shall remain effective until repealed by a formal Declaration of the Supervisor pursuant to Section 24 of the Executive Law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Staff, Departments, and Agencies of the Town of Cortlandt shall take all actions necessary to protect the residents of the community, protect property and infrastructure, and provide all other emergency assistance deemed necessary.
