An Important Notice

I am pleased to report that Watch Hill Road and Sniffen Mountain Road are paved as of today (June 5, 2015).

I want to thank our residents in that area and those that traverse these town roads for their patience and cooperation as we had to repair and then pave these roads.

This paving was a carry over from our 2014 paving bid due to the Con Edison infrastructure (gas line) work that occurred last year. They are paying for the cost of paving for their portion that needed resurfacing. The Town extended the paving to include a longer stretch of Watch Hill Road.

The 2015 paving takes place in early September after the Town Board and I award a bid. The list is developed by our staff, discussed with the Town Board for approval then it goes out to bid and awarded. There is a criteria that is used by the staff committee to determine which roads are to be paved each year.

Once again, thank you all so much for your patience on Watch Hill Road and Sniffen Mountain Road.
