Storm King Art Center & Sculpture Gardens is an open-air Museum. Founded in 1960 by Ralph E. Ogden as a museum for paintings, it soon evolved into a major sculpture venue, with works from some of the most acclaimed artists of the 20th Century. From the narrated tram ride, explore 200 carefully sited sculptures on 500 acres. Enjoy the inherent natural beauty of the region from the tram which includes Storm King's dramatic landscape of natural woodlands, native grasses, hills, meadows, wetlands and plants. See why Storm King is considered one of the world's leading sculpture parks located just 1 hour from north of NYC. Please note, there is some walking on this tour.
