Spectra/Algonquin Fight UPDATE: (April 13, 2015)

1. The press conference of April 2, 2015 is posted and aired on our channel 78 public access station and is streamed on our website.
2. DVD copies of this press conference have been sent to F.E.R.C., NRC, NYSDEC and to our two U.S. Senators.
3. S.A.P.E. will be chairing a press conference in Albany on April 27th, 11a.m. regarding health issues related to the expansion of the Spectra/Algonquin pipeline.
4. Our two U.S. Senators, Charles Schumer and Kristin Gillibrand have now joined us in our battle to stop this large and unsafe gas line project. They join many other elected officials at the federal, state, county and local level to protect our residents, area and environment.
5. The Town of Cortlandt, along with S.A.P.E. and other groups filed by April 2, 2015 (the deadline) to F.E.R.C. asking them to re-open and rehear our many issues in opposition to this project. They have 30 days to respond to all of us.
6. Many officials and groups are keeping up the efforts to have F.E.R.C. reopen the hearings, to do a better review and evaluation of our many critical issues in opposition to this expanded gas line proposal. We all need to keep up the pressure (keep in mind one of our objections is the 25% increase of pressure from this expanded gas line).
