

- To identify assets and challenges (Completed 2/11/10)
- To form an action plan (Completed 4/14/10)
- To create an implementation timeline (for Short Term and Long Term Projects. (Completed 6/8/10)
- To finalize a timeline for long-term plan implementation (9/28/10)

- Support for businesses in tough economic times
- Encourage business owners to enhance landscaping, curb appeal, etc.
- Pedestrian safety, crosswalks, "walk-ability"
- Additional open space opportunities

- Enhanced planting areas and awareness of historical sites along Route 9A

### MEP Short Term Items Completed as of 9/28/10

- 1. Striping of Kings Ferry Road by Ambulance Corp.
- 2. Busses eliminated on Dutch Street from the County George's Island Park.
- 3. DES Projects (Highway, Sanitation, Parks). Roundtree Lane picnic table removed, fence removed and a NO dumping sign installed.
- 4. Earth Day Event Saturday April 17th. Successful community participation. Kick-off was at the Montrose Gazebo
- 5. Litter Pickup and brush clean up on Route 9A
- 6. Smart Machine was placed on Harper Avenue. Contacted police departments to assist with traffic issues: Harper Avenue, Kings Ferry Road, etc.

#### MEP COMPLETED Items Continued

- 7. Loitering Issues Police departments were contacted.
- 8. Business Signs began Town Board action to streamline sign processes for small business owners.
- 9. Legal Reviews have taken place on properties on Route 9A in Montrose (Gas Stations).
- 10. Change Yield Sign to Stop Sign at intersection of King Ferry Road and Sunset Road
- 11. Add New 4 way stop signs at intersection of Montrose Point Road and Sunset.
- 12. Town Board public hearings on Moratorium issues to take place in 2010 to protect our neighborhoods.

#### MEP Items Completed (from 2/11/10)


- 13. Town to lobby NYSDOT for school zone speed limits & crosswalks across Route 9A. (April Town Board agenda)
- 14. Light at Trolley Road fixed
- 15. Route 9A Sidewalks from Kings Ferry Road to the VA: Design work begun.




#### Long Term Plans: Business / Economic Enhancement

- ❖ Banners for Route 9A/Montrose Area/Town of Cortlandt: Linda, Rosemary and Judi met with our volunteer committee to begin design of Banners to be added to the area. Two meetings were held one in August, one in September.
- ❖ Discussion of design ideas and locations. Color scheme discussed was light blue to dark blue with a photo of the historic Trolley from the Montrose area. (see next page for image).

#### Infrastructure Long Term Goals



- Route 9A Sidewalks between Kings Ferry Road and VA (Expected 2011)
- Final repairs to Montrose Station Road Bridge owned by Metro North (Expected 2011)
- NYSDOT Pedestrian Crosswalks on Route 9A (By 2012)
- Move Security Kiosk further into VA Property (Future Project)
- Diamond Interchange on Route 9A/Route 9 (Future Project)
- Request to Westchester County for George's Island to be transferred to the Town of Cortlandt (after they pave the parking lots)

#### Going Forward



- Continue our small committee to interact with Supervisor Puglisi and administration in the future to address infrastructure, beautification, business/economic and fundraising for projects and any other issues that might arise.
- Ongoing work and progress will continue for long term goals.
