The Town of Cortlandt Opposes the U.S. Coast Guard Anchors Plan for the Hudson River

The Town of Cortlandt continues to fight against the U.S. Coast Guard's proposed new anchors in the Hudson River including off the shores of the Town of Cortlandt (in our hamlet of Verplanck and Montrose).

These permanent anchors would allow large ships and barges to anchor to these locations in the Hudson River and would impact our community.

The Town of Cortlandt has invested millions of dollars to acquire land on the river and to construct lovely parks and docks for our rowing association and for kayaks. We do not want our vistas destroyed or our investments affected by this ill-conceived plan of the Coast Guard.
