

The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) Public Hearing regarding the Spectra/Algonquin Incremental Markets (AIM) Natural Gas pipeline, compressor and metering stations expansion project

Monday, September 15, 2014

6:30 p.m.

Spectra Energy is proposing to run a new 42 inch pipeline 1.2 miles beneath the Hudson River from Stony Point to Verplanck. They will then proceed to install a 42 inch pipe from Verplanck, through the Village of Buchanan and continuing through Northern Westchester. The expanded pipeline will be located within 500 feet of the Buchanan Verplanck School and thousands of private homes in the area.
