The Town of Cortlandt is pleased to inform you that Solarize Croton-Cortlandt, an exciting opportunity for our residents and businesses – has been extended until June 25!

The Village of Croton and the Town of Cortlandt were selected to participate in the Solarize Westchester program, an initiative that makes installing quality solar systems easy and affordable for homeowners and commercial property owners. Solarize Croton-Cortlandt offers discounted rates through a group purchasing model, paired with generous state and federal incentives. The Town of Cortlandt and Village of Croton are the first municipalities in Westchester to offer the Solarize program twice – the current Solarize campaign follows a highly successful campaign in 2015.


Solarize Westchester is offered to Westchester municipalities by Sustainable Westchester, with technical support from the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA). The program leverages group discounts through a competitively selected installer to reduce the cost of solar, while relying on a dedicated team of community volunteers to provide outreach and education to create awareness and build interest during the campaign. Key features include:

- **Discount Price:** Pricing of quality solar systems through this program is significantly below average market price.
- **Financing:** There are a variety of financing options offered by solar contractors that make solar more affordable than ever, often including leasing and loan options that require **no money down**.
- **Deadline:** **Solarize Croton-Cortlandt has been extended to June 25th 2018.** All contracts must be signed by that date in order to qualify for the discounted cost.

Many solar contractors bid competitively to participate in Solarize Croton-Cortlandt, Solar Liberty was selected, based on their value and ability to meet the needs of the community.
