- Copy of contractor's Westchester County <u>Home Improvement License</u>;
- With The Town of Cortlandt identified as "Certificate Holder", provide proof of Insurance Certificates for <u>Liability</u>, <u>Worker's Compensation</u> (CE-200 form, C-105.2, SJ-12, GSI-105.2), and <u>Disability</u> (CE-200, DB-120.1, DB-155). Note that ACORD Forms are not acceptable proof;
- If the Homeowner elects not to retain a licensed contractor, include Homeowner's Insurance Declaration of Coverage;
- \$50 Permit Fee if greater than 3 trees to be removed. Checks are made payable to The Town of Cortlandt;
- Submit the Application, supporting documentation, and the fee (if applicable) to the <u>Code Enforcement Division</u>.

TREE REMOVAL CHECKLIST

The items listed below are requirements of this application.

RESIDENTIAL

- Estimate prepared by a licensed and insured tree removal company indicating the number of trees, type, and diameter at breast height proposed to be removed.
- 2. Homeowner or authorized proxy provides details of the purpose of the proposed removal.
- 3. If <u>less than</u> 10 trees are proposed to be removed: Provide sketch or copy of a site plan/survey indicating the location of the property and property boundaries, the location of structures, driveways, and roadways on the property, and the location of the proposed removal(s).
- 4. If more than 10 trees are proposed to be removed: submit a tree removal plan and landscape mitigation plan prepared by a New York State licensed professional (landscape architect, architect, engineer, or certified arborist).
- 5. Tag or mark the trees to be removed prior to inspection.
- 6. Following project completion, notify the Engineering Division at (914) 734-1060. The Town will re-inspect the site for compliance with all conditions of the Permit. Upon satisfactory review, a Certificate of Compliance will be issued.

COMMERCIAL

- 1. Estimate prepared by a licensed and insured tree removal company indicating the number of trees, type, and diameter at breast height proposed to be removed.
- 2. A written statement signed by the property owner or authorized proxy (tenant) detailing the purpose of the proposed removal.
- 3. A tree removal plan prepared by a New York State licensed professional (architect, engineer, landscape architect, or certified arborist) showing the location of the property and property boundaries, the location of structures, onsite utilities, driveways and roadways on the property, and the location of the proposed work. Note that if more than 3 trees are proposed to be removed, a landscape mitigation plan shall be submitted as well.
- 4. If more than 10 trees are proposed to be removed Planning Board approval may be required.
- 5. Response to Conservation Advisory Council comments.
- 6. Tag or mark the trees to be removed prior to inspection.
- 7. Following project completion, notify the Engineering Division at (914) 734-1060. The Town will re-inspect the site for compliance of all conditions of the Permit. Upon satisfactory review, a Certificate of Compliance will be issued.
