- **Food Choices: When a trip cancellation occurs and the spot is filled, the senior must accept the previously selected food choice due to restaurant requirements.**
- **As schedules may fluctuate throughout the day, you may want to bring snacks, water or a few dollars spending money**
- **Regarding gambling trips: You must have a valid NYS photo ID or a specific casino players card to receive any casino package. It is also suggested that you have a partner w/you.**
