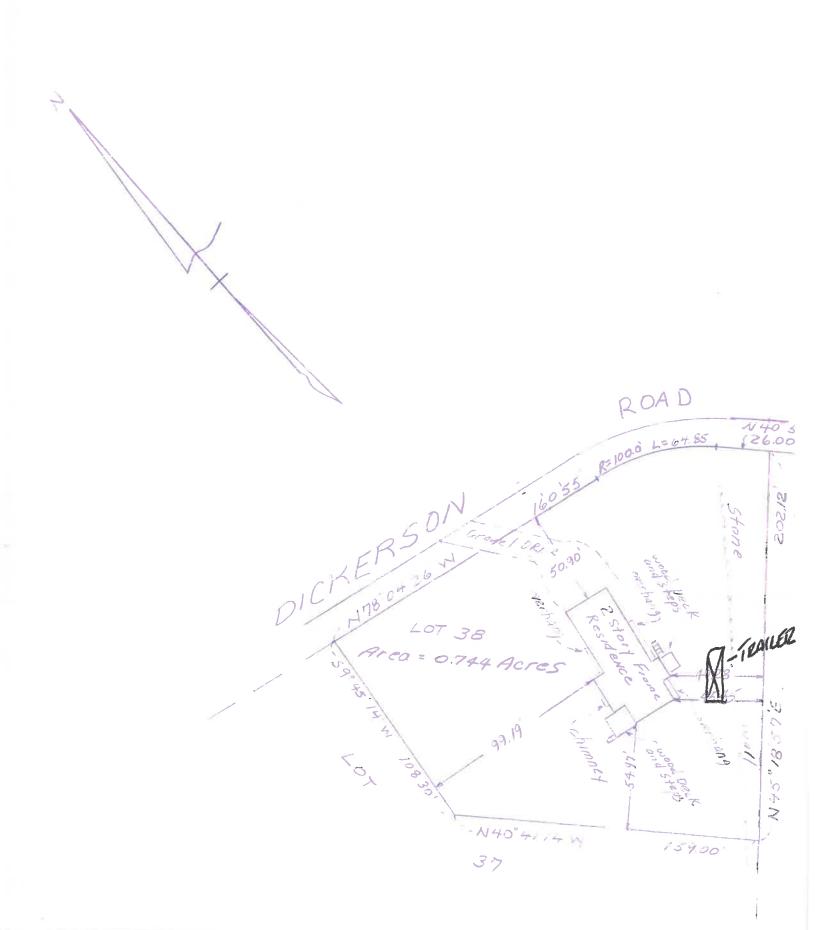

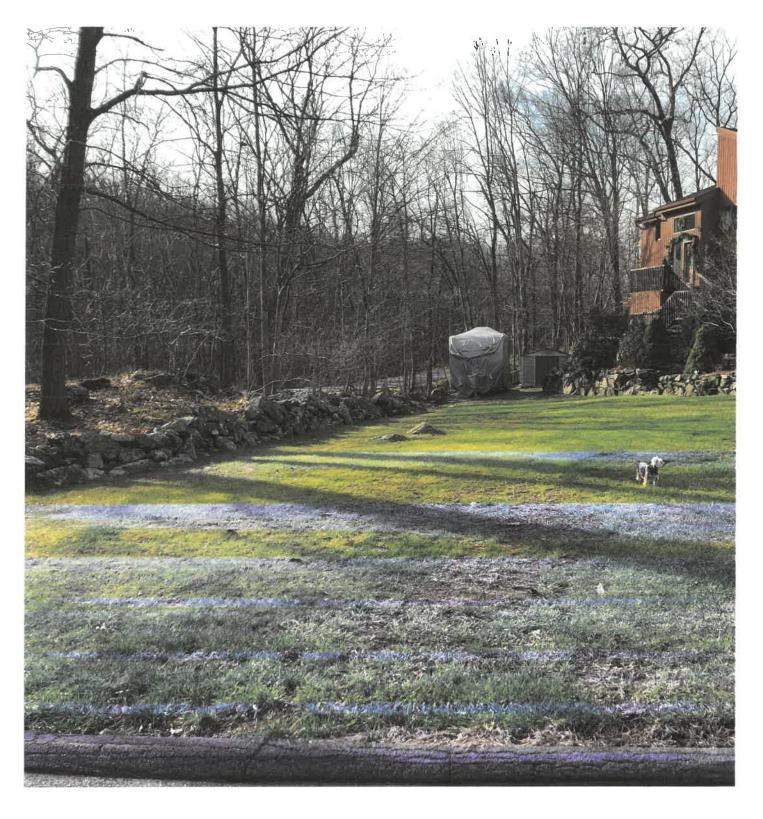
Dear Code Enforcement Team,

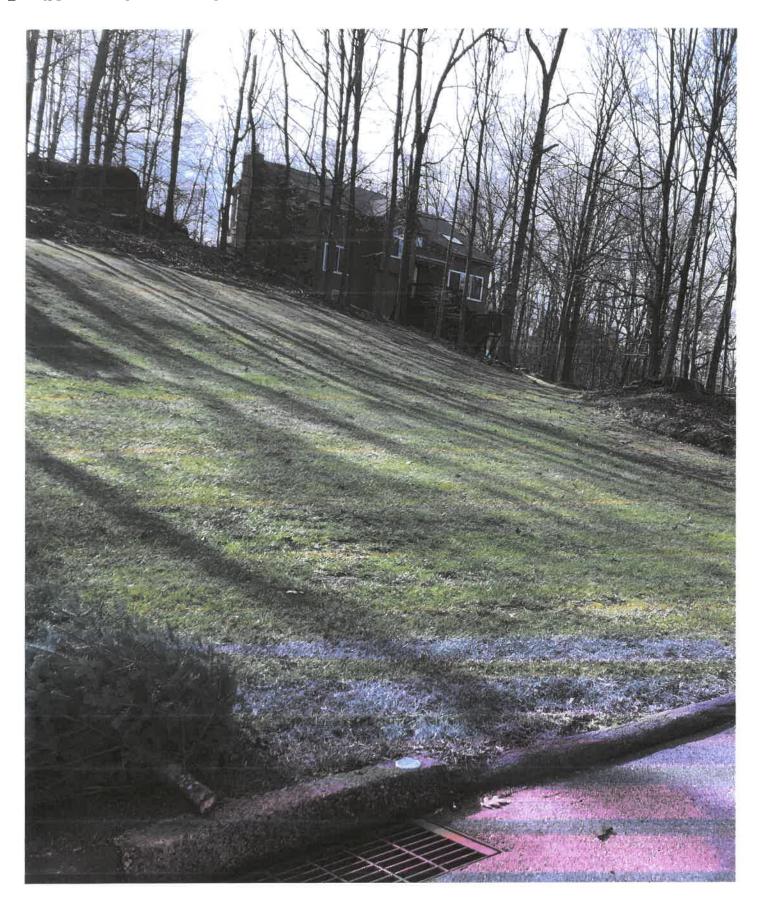
