Initial review has been performed for the Site Drawing for the above location. The following was noted:

- 1. Comply with Chapter 319 NYFC Mobile Food Preparation vehicles;
- 2. Comply with Chapter 901 NYSFC fire protection systems;
- 3. Comply w Chapter 904 NYSC extinguishing systems;
- 4. Comply with Chapter 607 NYSFC commercial kitchen hoods; and
- 5. Comply with Section 105.6 NYSFC operating permits;

OPERATING PERMIT – (description) Mobile food preparation vehicles that are equipped with appliances that produce smoke or grease-laden vapors (Chapter 319 NYSFC; Chapter 901 NYSFC; and Section 105.6 NYSFC)

Add as condition: External Equipment: No external equipment. All equipment must be located within or on the mobile unit at all times. Propane tanks should be secured to the vehicle or properly enclosed and supported outside the vehicle.
